DESCRIPTION

Looking across Copper Mountain Ski area from the fourth story crow's nest, the "Lumberjack Lodge" has unparalleled views of the SKY Chutes. The hand-hewn beams, scraped trim details and hand-scraped walnut floors give this mountain retreat a "grand ski lodge" feel. With the Lumberjack Lift right in the back yard, this single-family residence has easy skier access.

The heated cobblestone driveway leads to an over-sized, heated two-car garage, complete with a bike washbasin.

Each of the seven bedrooms in this home has its own character created by Hamer Interior Design: bear, moose, cowboy, Indian, skier and so on. The plumbing fixtures in all of the seven full and two half baths are unique and give charm to each room. The two master bedrooms each have their own steam shower and access to patio and deck space.

This home features a modern, structured wiring package with fully automated lighting and a climate control system. One touch of a button can turn off all of the house lights or turn all of the thermostats down to an "away" setting. The automation system also allows the homeowner to control the home via the Internet, so thermostats can be remotely turned up when returning home from a prolonged stay away.

The wall-to-wall wood in the great room, which encompasses the kitchen, gives warmth to the main gathering area of the home. A large deck opens from the great room, displaying an amazing view of the Copper Mountain ski slope and views of the Ten Mile Range. A large, stone fireplace will call the crew together and warm them all around the open flame when night arrives.

The kitchen has top-of-the-line GE Monogram appliances. It opens to the great room, so the cook will never be lonely while preparing dinner in this well-thought-out kitchen. This "Built Green" home has blown-in foam insulation to keep the cold at bay and in-floor radiant heat to keep everyone's feet warm and cozy. With Control 4 lighting, technology blends beautifully with the rustic elegance of the "Lumberjack Lodge."

DIRECTIONS

Take I-70 west to the Copper Mountain/Leadville exit. Turn right at Copper Mountain Resort. Drive through Copper Mountain Village on Copper Road, past Union Creek to Lewis Ranch Gate. Continue through the gate and up the hill on Beeler Place to 1018 Beeler Place.
